

MAKE YOUR OWN CANDLE!



You will need:

crayons with paper removed,
or wax chips
small taper candle
milk carton, pint size
plastic freezer bag with seal
boiling water
crushed ice

Instructions:

1. Cut off the top of a milk carton so that you have an open-ended square.
2. Bring water to a boil over medium-high heat.
3. Place crayons or wax chips in plastic bag and seal. Place bag in boiling water until crayons or wax chips melt.
4. Place taper candle in the center of the milk carton and then fill carton with crushed ice.
5. Pour melted crayon or wax mixture into the carton.
6. Let sit until the candle has hardened and the ice has melted, then carefully cut and peel away the milk carton from the candle.

Note: Ask a grown-up for help with using the stove and pouring the heated mixture!

JESUS IS COMING

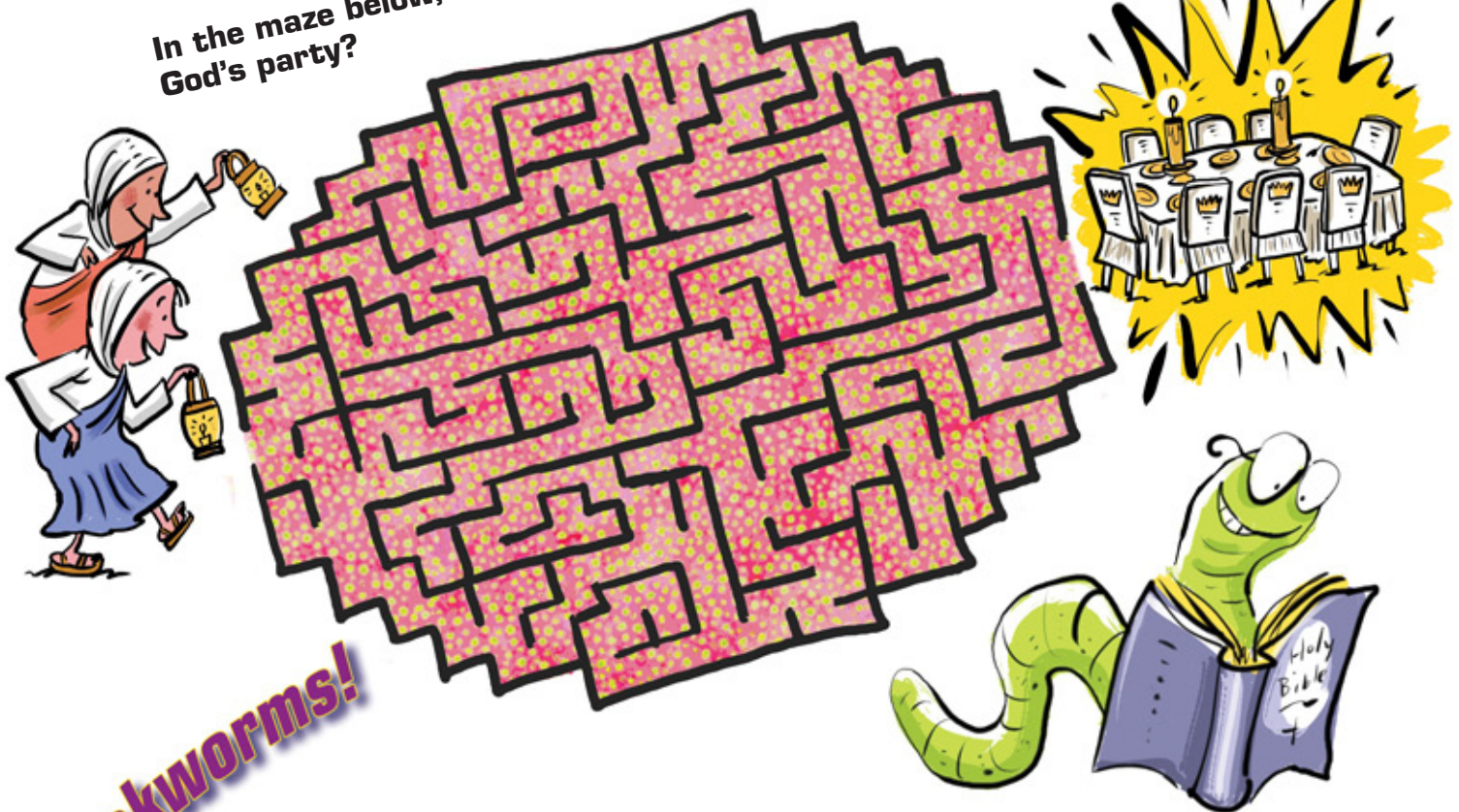
Imagine you were invited to a wonderful party. How would you feel?
